2025 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

- Must be a military ID Card holder either currently or previously affiliated with Fort Drum.
- Must be a High School Senior graduating in 2025 **OR** currently enrolled in a full-time accredited program of study at an undergraduate or graduate level.
- Must be **accepted into or attending** an accredited college (to include four-year colleges/universities, two-year colleges, and community colleges), accredited trade school, Police Academy, Fire Academy, or EMS/Ambulance Academy.
- Must commence program of study no later than the first academic year following the awarding of the scholarship
- Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, political affiliation, gender identification, social or economic status

SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS:

- Will be notified of their selection, in writing
- Will be required to attend the Scholarship Awards Ceremony to receive their scholarship in person
- Will be required to present Military ID Card prior to receipt of their Award
- Awards are made in the form of a check to the accredited school contingent on proof of enrollment
- Awards will be dispersed per the institution's financial aid policies
- Awards are restricted to payment of tuition, fees, books, and room and board
- If a Scholarship Recipient is awarded a full academic scholarship (to include fees, books, and room and board) from another entity after this program's scholarships have been awarded, all funds awarded must be returned to North Country Spouses' Club immediately

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Incomplete applications will NOT be considered. Applications sent by email will NOT be considered without a valid wet ink signature and proper scanning procedures. Emailed applications must be scanned clearly with no scanning imperfections; photo images of applications will not be accepted. Applications MUST be emailed before 11:59pm EST, March 24, 2025 to be eligible for consideration. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to extend the deadline if deemed necessary.
